6.3B The Percent Proportion Word Problems

The Percent Proportion

Words You can represent "a is p percent of w" with the proportion

$$\frac{a}{w} = \frac{p}{100}$$

where a is part of the whole w, and p%, or $\frac{p}{100}$, is the percent.


Numbers

3 out of 4 is 75%.

$$\frac{\text{part}}{\text{whole}} \Rightarrow \frac{3}{4} = \frac{75}{100} \leftarrow \frac{\text{percent}}{\text{percent}}$$

<u>Ex</u>: The Enhanced Fujita Scale (EF Scale) is used to rate the strength of a tornado. The bar graph shows the strengths of tornadoes that occurred in Alabama in 2011. What percent of the tornadoes were EF1s?

2011 Alabama Tornadoes

Whole = 36+58+29+13+7+2=145
