RECOMMENDED SUPPLIES

• Five-subject spiral notebook (Geometry will also need a one-subject spiral to be used as a GeoPH)

Try to get the spirals with the **folders** separating the sections (also with a plastic cover); the folders will be used to hold on to assignments, tests/quizzes, handouts and chapter assignment sheets. The three sections will be used for **1**) warm-ups/classwork, **2**) notes (2 sections) and **3**) HW (2 sections)

• Pencils, red-correcting pens, highlighters, glue sticks, ruler, protractor, and graph paper

Optional: if you do purchase a calculator, TI-30XIIS is recommended as it is used in the high schools. Instruction on use of calculators will be given in class.

IN ORDER TO RECEIVE FULL CREDIT AND BENEFIT FROM YOUR WORK

- Use the chapter assignment page or check your teacher's website: so you know the exact assignment to complete that day: www.MathMovesU.weebly.com
- Always use pencil for homework assignments no pens, not even the erasable type!
- Use graph paper to work on problems during the graphing units.
- Write out the problem as stated in the book (unless it is a word problem, then copy important information).
- SHOW ALL YOUR WORK! NO WORK, NO CREDIT! THIS INCLUDES HW/TESTS/QUIZZES!
- At home, **correct odd questions** by using the back, **correct even questions** by using the key posted on the class Weebly website, and **show all corrections using red pen**.
- Use correct heading Ex) Assign #24 Page 213, #1-27 odd and highlight all titles.

• Begin warm-up, writing the problems and solutions in your spiral.

This is also the time to show your teacher any make-up work and homework corrections.

HOMEWORK POLICY

Homework is a way for you to learn more by extending the work that was started during class time. It could also be a review of material previously covered, an introduction to new ideas for later follow-up in class, or a chance to reflect on ideas discussed in class. You will have approximately 30 minutes of homework, Monday through Friday each week. Homework should be done each evening and is worth 5 points per assignment.

LATE WORK WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR FULL CREDIT ONLY BEFORE THE END OF EACH CHAPTER.

Corrections will be done on every test/quiz to correct all missed problems.

ASSIGNMENT SHEETS

An assignment sheet will be given at the beginning of each chapter and will be posted on the teacher's website. IF YOU ARE ABSENT, TRY TO DO THE NEXT ASSIGNMENT ON THE SHEET. We do one assignment daily. If you have questions about the assignment, see your teacher before school on the day you return, ask your parents, or call a friend in class to get help with your questions. All absent assignments should be completed within the same number of days as the length of the absence. It is YOUR responsibility to turn in the make-up work so that you can receive credit. Changes to the assignment sheet will be posted on the class Weebly website.

EXTRA HELP

Lunchtime help is available every day, in the classroom. Additionally, a list of wonderful internet resources has been posted on the class Weebly website.

GRADES

<u>Homework</u> will be stamped each day by the teacher and will be graded based on accuracy by you. You will give yourself an accuracy grade based on the number of problems you solved correctly. Then it will be your responsibility to show the teacher your corrections in red pen for each missed homework problem. In this way, you may earn 100% on each homework assignment. You will keep track of these points on the assignment sheet, and the teacher will update these points after each set of corrections are completed. Your parents will sign this "Portfolio" at the end of each chapter before you turn it in. The day after the chapter test, this homework portfolio will be collected and used for the homework grade for that chapter. <u>Notes</u> and <u>Warm-Ups</u> will also be graded the day after each chapter test.

<u>Quizzes</u> are given about halfway into a chapter, or when needed. <u>Tests</u> are given at the conclusion of every chapter. <u>Trimester benchmarks</u> are given by the district and will be counted as a test grade. Projects will be assigned with an equivalent value of a test. The grades for the class are cumulative for each trimester.
